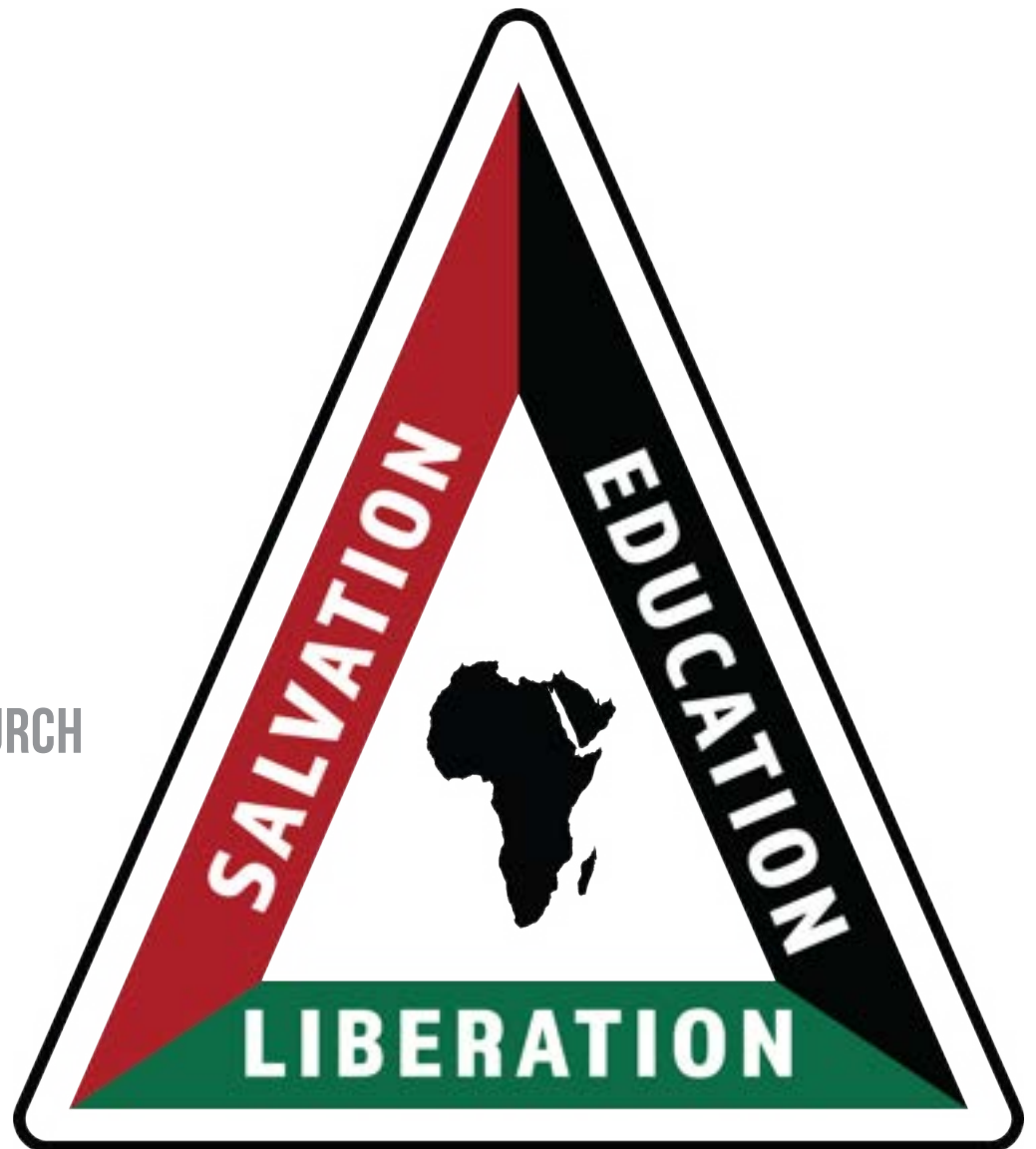

And he said, I will not destroy it for ten's sake. 33 And the LORD went his way, as soon as he had left communing with Abraham: and Abraham returned unto his place.*

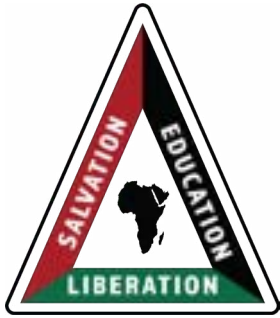

## **Death of Betty Shabazz**

Wife of Malcolm X and mother of six (6) daughters. After the murder of Malcolm X, Betty Shabazz returned to school earning a doctorate in higher education administration. She worked as an associate professor at Medgar Evers College in New York, and later as a university administrator and fund raiser. Her death was the result of injuries sustained in fire.

## **Godwin Ajala**

The only Nigerian listed among the nearly 3,000 people who died 9/11/01. On the day of September 11, 2001, Ajala demonstrated his self-sacrificing character when, instead of running to save his own life, he helped to evacuate thousands of people from a street-level security post inside the lobby of Two World Trade Center when the second plane hit the building. He held the door open for people running out, and repeatedly went back inside to guide more people out of the blazing structure. Exhausted after helping to guide many out of the attacked building, Ajala reportedly first went into a coma and died the following Sunday.
